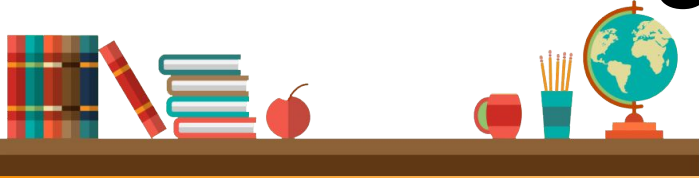

Cold Weather Policy:

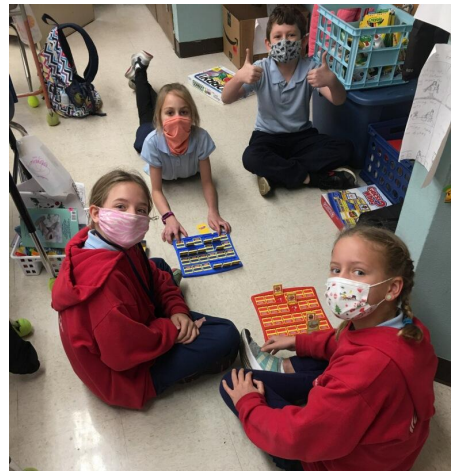

The first day to apply is January 11th, 2021.

Parents of students entering kindergarten, please note:

The Alive in Christ Scholarship gives preference to NEW students even if they are not your oldest child in school.

We encourage you to apply if you think you might be eligible. The scholarships are awarded on a first-come, first-served basis, so **apply** on January 11th or as soon as possible after that date.

The deadline for applications is February 26th, 2021.
