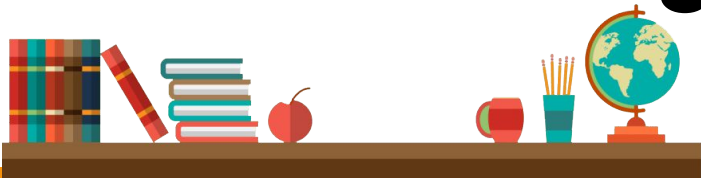

**Inclement Weather:**

If school is cancelled for inclement weather, I will send out a Fast Direct notice, post on our school Facebook page, and post on Channels on 2, 4, & 5.

Per our Family Handbook, once school is in session, classes will not be dismissed due to weather. If the weather is bad but not necessary for school to cancel, students will not be marked tardy until 9:00am. It is up to the parent’s discretion as to whether they feel it is necessary, due to road conditions or forecast, to not bring their children or pick up their students before dismissal.

**Cold Weather Policy:**

With colder weather finally upon us, please keep in mind that students will go outside for full recess when wind chill temps are 21-95 degrees, 15 minutes outside when wind chill temps are 15-20 degrees, and inside recess when wind chill temps are 0-15 degrees. We will use Channel 5 Weather App to make determinations. So please make sure your child has appropriate outerwear.

**Disinfectant Wipes:**

We are always in need of disinfectant wipes! Any donations would be greatly appreciated.

**Parent Pick Up:**

No matter the reason, if a student does not walk out to the dismissal line at 3:00pm but their ride is there, please swing down with the car line and head to Supervised Study to pick them up. Please remember to refrain from parking on the yellow lines.
