

Reentry Plan Updates:

* Please remember that your child needs to be fever free (with no meds) and vomit free for 24 hours or longer. No matter the reason for vomiting, students still need to be home for 24 hours.

* When you email your teacher regarding the reason for your child's illness, please include myself or Donna Sahm.

* We plan to send home a student set of daily health forms each month in the Wednesday envelopes.

* While anyone in your household is awaiting testing, please keep your students at home to distance learn. If the test results come back negative, your students are able to return to the school building. If the results come back positive, then we have caught it a few days earlier and helps keep everyone healthier.

* Please pack extra masks as some break or even end up in the toilet!

* Birthday treats need to be individually wrapped store bought items during this time.

* Pick up for the 3pm dismissal where cars go choose to go into either line has been going smoothly. Thank you for being flexible! Please make sure to be in line by 3:00pm.

* **Free Supervised Study is 3:00-3:30pm.**

* **Paid FAST is 3:30-6:00pm.**

* Please launder your child's clothes (and sweatshirts), wash water bottles, and masks, as soon as they get home EVERY DAY!!!!

* I would highly suggest that your child have an activity kit (crayons, paper, etc.) in his/her backpack for arrival and after school pick up.

* Please make sure to label your child's water bottle as we have identical ones.

* I understand that it is easy to become more relaxed with our reentry plan over time. However, Kindergarten told me today that we have been in person learning for 15 days. 15 days, that is amazing! Let's keep that going! Protect our nest!

Turn Left onto Mill Rd. to Concord Hill Rd.
Turn Left on Hwy 94 (east)

Turn Right on Pecan St.
Continue onto west South St.
Cross 1st St. and continue onto east South St.
Turn Left on south 3rd St. (1 block past St. Paul's UOC)

From South 3rd St., Turn Right on Hwy D (East Main St.)
